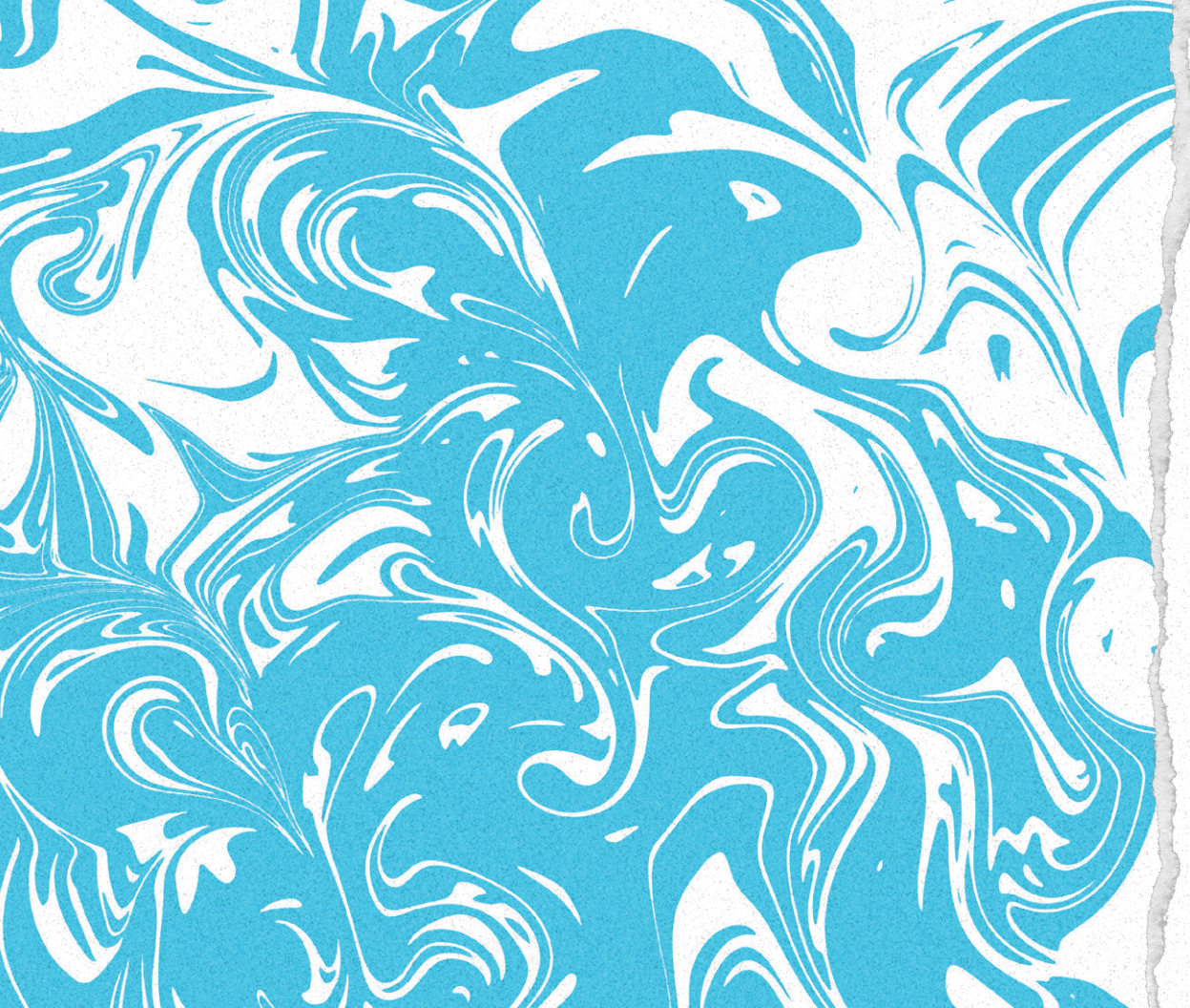

PARTNERING *with* PARENTS

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES?

INTRO MAKER

Greets students each week, makes sure they are signed in for the evening and answers basic questions for students and parents at drop-off.

TECHNOLOGY/ SOUND TEAM

Make sure that the audio/visual for each event is prepped and runs without being a hindrance to the event, enhancing the students' ability to hear from God.

SPECIAL EVENTS PROS

Leaders who have the ability to participate, host and/or help camps, retreats and seasonal adventures/events.

SECURITY

Leaders who are passionate about safety and enjoy establishing and enforcing boundaries with care for students are needed at each event.

FOODIES

Leaders who like to connect over food are invited to bring their favorite treats and help set up/serve/clean up snacks for each event.

TEACHERS

Skilled speakers and planners that enjoy sharing the Bible in an applicable way for students on a rotating schedule.

WORSHIP LEADERS

Skilled musicians who want to share their gifts with students and help students learn and grow in leading worship and are willing to commit to the time it takes to prep worship with student leaders.

GAME SHOW HOSTS

Creatives with high energy who like to organize and plan games and object lessons to get students engaged in the content of the lesson.

SMALL GROUP LEADERS

Gifted in interpersonal connections and facilitating groups, these leaders are in the hot seat each week to be the visual model and main connection for an assigned small group of students. These leaders have the opportunity to develop relationships that grow each year as students transition in the ministry. Small group leader communication extends beyond the time spent at a ministry event and throughout the week.
